The Gospel all Over the World

Dear friends,

Greetings in the name of the Lord Jesus!

Pakistan Update:

After an absence of 17 years, I finally felt a release from the Lord to go to Pakistan. I first flew to Karachi, where I spent almost a year in prison for preaching the Gospel when I first received Jesus.

I was received at Karachi Airport by two army officers, who had served under my father. One of them was now the commanding officer of the Airport Security Force. These men really rolled out the red carpet for me and I was shown great honor thenceforth at every airport in Pakistan.

From Karachi, I flew to Lahore. I must say it was

rather unnerving when the pilot announced as we began our descent to land, "Ladies and Gentlemen, this is your captain speaking. If it is the will of Allah, we shall soon be landing at Lahore International airport!" I said to myself, "I don't care what Allah wants. Jesus is with me, and we are getting down safely!"

Lahore is where I received the Lord Jesus, got my first Bible, and heard the voice of the Lord for the first time, as well as, where I was arrested, and where I was locked up in a mental asylum for my faith in Christ. I was asked by a local pastor to minister at a healing service.

I was escorted to the venue by armed men. As I entered the place I was amazed to see over 25,000 people attending! About

forty percent were Muslims, including women in veils and entire Muslim families. Imagine, these were people who never heard the Gospel, but they came because they heard that Jesus Christ heals the sick!

In preparation for the meeting, over a thousand people had fasted and prayed that day. The power of God was mighty in that place. As I stood upon the platform, my right hand began to shake uncontrollably and I stared at it in amazement. I had never experienced a thing like that before.

When I got up to preach the Gospel the Fire of the Lord fell, and over 8000 people received the Lord Jesus. God then sent a wave of healing power over the crowd, and multitudes were healed; deaf, blind, paralyzed, etc.

There were just too many to number.

There were military officers in the meeting who had served under my dad and knew my family. They were absolutely floored, knowing I was from a strong Muslim family, when they saw me preaching the Gospel! All glory to Jesus!

Heavily armed police were there in force to protect us, in the event that Muslim extremists would try to cause problems. The Pakistani government has come down very hard upon extremists and terrorists, and we experienced no violence or persecution! My one regret was that this was only a one-night meeting!

From Lahore, I traveled to the capital city, Islamabad, to spend time with a retired Colonel who

was my best friend when we were officer cadets. He cried when he saw me after all these years. I spent three days with him and his family, and had the opportunity to share the Gospel with them. After which he asked me to pray for them!

We are thankful for the opportunities we have to share the Lord Jesus with people, be it to a soccer-field packed with a mass of humanity or one on one with an individual human being.


People are precious to God. They are so precious to Him that when Jesus came, He did not come for the gold or silver of the world, but for the people. People are what Jesus died to save!

The very last recorded words of the Lord Jesus upon this earth, before He ascended to Heaven are found in Acts 1:8, "But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Spirit comes upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth."

How did His disciples respond? We find the answer in March 16:20, "And they went forth, and preached everywhere, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following."

Jesus speaks and those who love Him with all our hearts rise up to obey His bidding. It's like when David sighed and uttered a longing for a drink of water from the well of his boyhood village of Bethlehem, and three of his foremost *mighty men* heard his sigh they arose and left everything. Drawing their swords, they ran toward the Philistines, who then occupied Bethlehem.

They fought their way to the well, got some water,

and fought their way back to David. David was stunned. His slightest sigh had become something that they were willing to die for! As for David, he did not count himself worthy to drink that water, but poured it out as an offering to the Lord.

I am talking about love, devotion, and passion. People sometimes ask me what it is that drives me. Let me tell you. A couple of days after I first gave my life to Jesus, a young American called Judd McKendry asked me, "You have given your life to Jesus; do you know of the conditions to follow

Him?" I answered him that I did not. He took out his Bible and opened it to Luke 9:23-24.

I was 21 years old and this was the first time in my life that my eyes had ever seen a Bible. Judd had me read the passage, and it said, "If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow me. For whosoever will save his life shall lose it: but whosoever will lose his life for my sake, the same shall save it."

I understood that to be a follower of Jesus I had to choose the path of self-denial. I had to take up the cross daily. Jesus took up His cross only once, and that was when He was going to die. I had to be ready to die daily. If I was not ready to die for Him, then I was not fit to live for Him.

This was branded into my heart that day, and soon after that I spent nearly a year in prison for the Gospel. I was overwhelmed that God had counted me worthy to suffer for His Name's sake.

Many years have passed since then, and I live in another land half way across the world, but I am still walking that path and carrying that cross. The Calvary Road is a path of sacrifice, but also of joy unspeakable and victory.

It is the joy of walking in the footsteps of our Master and embracing that which is most precious to Him, the cause of the Gospel to the nations. It is also the joy of seeing multitudes of souls coming to Jesus, and the joy of seeing God confirm His Word with miracle-working power. After all these years, that Fire burns in my heart as fierce as ever. As it was written in Leviticus 6:13 over 4000 years ago, "The Fire shall ever be burning upon the altar; it shall

never go out."

Let us keep that Fire going in our hearts, in our home altars, and in our churches! Many have thrown away their zeal for missions, for taking the Gospel to the nations, and have traded it for other things that they find less challenging yet more gratifying for the eyes. Their sermons are good motivational speeches, but the fire and the passion are gone. Let us not let it happen to us. Keep the fire burning!

This is harvest time. Let us keep on preaching the Gospel, and continue winning souls for Jesus!

Multitudes Meet Jesus in Ngombe, Zambia

"If God be for us, who can be against us? He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?"

Romans 8:31-32

Dear friends,

Greetings in the name of the Lord Jesus!

In this newsletter, I will be reporting on our recent crusade in Ngombe, Zambia. First, I will share about my latest trip to Asia.

The situation in Asia continues to be very tense. There is tremendous pressure upon Christians and churches. The military and the intelligence services have actively made things very difficult for Christians, and many churches and bible schools have been raided and shut down by the authorities for being "illegal."

Normally, at this time of the year, we hold a public

crusade and a School of Ministry for pastors from all over the nation; however, due to the present situation, we were only able to hold a week-long School of Ministry for the pastors and leaders from the churches that we have planted.

The School of Ministry was held in the capital city of Yangon. Pastors and leaders came from all over the nation; some traveled as much as three days to get there.

Through the generosity of our partners, we were able to provide food, lodging, and transportation expenses for all who attended. It was a special time of teaching, fellowship, and encouragement for everybody; the Spirit of the Lord was present in our midst.

Ministering alongside me was Scott Fletcher, a missionary who is associated

with Dynamis World Ministries. Scott and his wife, Krista, live in Chiang Mai, Thailand, together with their three children.

Brother William, who is our director of operations in Asia, also ministered in the teaching sessions.

Our churches are spread out into unreached areas all over the country. In spite of the hostile and difficult conditions that most of our churches operate under, they all had good victory reports, including strong church growth, people receiving Jesus, and wonderful testimonies of God's

healing power and provision. It was exciting news!

It was a great joy to spend the time with our pastors and leaders, to see the fruits of our labors, and to see how our church planters have grown and developed from eager youngsters to mature men and women of God. They are being mightily used by God to take the Gospel of Jesus to their nation, and they are bringing much honor and glory to our Lord Jesus.

One region of Asia did not even have one single in-

digenous believer or church! Everyone was Buddhist, Muslim, or animist. Today, we have three thriving and growing congregations that were started by our Training Center for Church Planter graduates. They are actively spreading the Gospel in that region.

In another area where we had a crusade, there was not a single Christian at

that time. This area is located by a war zone where insurgents are very active in fighting the army. Many people received Jesus in that crusade. We sent two of the young men who received Jesus to our training center.

After graduation, we sent them back to that region to plant a church. Today, they lead a growing and thriving

congregation of over 200 people. In addition, they have new and growing groups planted in four nearby villages.

One family, who receives this newsletter, gave \$4000 to purchase land and to build a church building, which is now up and ready for them to use!

I wish those of you who have faithfully supported the planting of churches and the building of church buildings in Asia could have been there with me to see the fruit of your love, faith, and giving. We are thankful to the Lord for all that He is doing and for all that He has done.

To those who stand with us, there is still so much to be done. We assure you that we shall continue to preach the Gospel in Asia with undiminished vision, faith, zeal, passion, and with the power of the Holy Ghost!

From Asia, I was scheduled to go to the Middle East for meetings, but I received news of the heavy rioting and violence brought on by the offensive cartoons of Mohamed that were published in the newspapers in Denmark. As a result, the meetings were canceled, and I spent this time instead in Thailand and Singapore. I had the opportunity to visit some missionaries and had a couple days of rest before flying to Zambia for our Africa crusade.

Our Africa crusade team, which is led by Pastor Mavondo, prepared the crusade together with the local pastors and congregations in the township. The rainy season in Zambia normally ends at the end of February or early March. This year however, heavy rains continued into the second week of March and affected our crusade in Ngombe.

It rained every day, but the Lord answered our prayers; the rain would stop early in the evenings enabling us to hold our

Peter Moyo, 25, was very ill. He only moved and walked very slowly and with great difficulty. As Jesus healed him he jumped and ran for joy!

Christina Lungu, 41, was blind in both eyes for two years. Jesus healed her, and now she sees!

Mandela Siyajane, 20, was severely ill for one year. As a result, he could not walk properly; limping badly on one leg. Jesus healed him, and now he walks and runs properly.

crusade meetings. Great multitudes of people came out each night to hear the Word of God. They responded to the altar call for salvation and received Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior!

The Lord did many wonderful miracles and healings, confirming His Word that was preached. Every evening we saw deaf people receive their hearing and blind people receive their sight. Others were healed from a host of diseases and infirmities, and the demon-possessed were set free. Paralyzed people were healed and began running, jumping, and dancing for joy.

Jesus touched one paralyzed woman who was carried in on a chair. She stood up and began to walk and run. As she realized what the Lord had done for her, she began to weep. When she came up on the platform, she could-

n't speak; she just cried, totally overcome by the grace and power of God. There was great rejoicing in Ngombe at the wonderful works of God!

On the last night of the crusade it began to rain, and it literally poured through the entire service. We covered our sound system with tarpaulins and kept it running. As the rain fell upon me, I stood totally soaked and preached the Gospel.

The huge crowd that was gathered stayed to hear the message in spite of the heavy rain. Those who had umbrellas used them while the rest stood without cover. It rained through the altar call, and through the prayer for the sick as God did many wonderful miracles. It kept on pouring through the baptism with the Holy Ghost and with

Fire. Through it all, the Holy Ghost fell with great power. The people were filled with the Holy Ghost, and began speaking with other tongues.

We ended the crusade worshipping God and praising

faith together with ours for souls to come to Jesus. Thank you for your prayers and for your faithful and sacrificial financial giving that God uses to make all this possible.

All glory to our Lord Jesus!




