Dear Friends,

Greetings in Jesus Name! I will be sharing with you about our recent crusade in Tafara, Zimbabwe, but first, I will report briefly on the situation in Asia.

Asia Update

The situation in Asia is still very tough for those Christians who continue to stand up to preach the Gospel and refuse to compromise. Our Training Center for Church Planters and Pioneers is basically operating "underground", and we are presently in the middle of the 2007 school year.

A pastor of one of the churches we planted reported that God has done several outstanding miracles in his

church. News of this spread like wildfire, because the people healed openly glorified Jesus and eagerly testified of what the Lord had done for them.

Now, since he and his congregation were preaching the Gospel to sinners, healing the sick, and casting out devils they are being subjected to severe threats from the local authorities. They were told they would face dire consequences if they did not stop.

I found myself faced with answering the questions, "What should we do?" In response, I gathered my leaders and explained that there are three things that are non-negotiable in our ministry.

1. Preaching the Gospel to the lost.

2. Healing the sick and casting out devils.

3. Planting new churches.

These 3 things are non-negotiable and we will never stop doing them. These are our core values and it is what we are all about.

Over time we may change some of our methods, but compromise with the devil and his servants is totally out of the question. We are on the winning side. Jesus has triumphed over Satan and all his power. So, what do we have to fear?

My team in Asia is in agreement. And so, this is where we have taken our stand.

Tafara, Zimbabwe

Tafara is a township about twenty kilometers outside the capital city of Harare. We had held a crusade there a few years back, but felt it was time for another crusade because of the way the population shifts in Africa.

The crusade was prepared well by our Africa team, which is led by Pastor Mavondo. Many local churches enthusiastically participated in our pre-crusade Mobile Bible School.

Two couples, who are friends of mine from Singapore, flew to Harare and joined me for the crusade. Their presence created much excitement since the people had never before seen Chinese Christians - the only Chinese they knew were godless communists from the Peoples' Republic of China.

There was great excitement when the crusade started, and the Lord began to move with power from the very beginning. The first night, we saw two lame people get up and begin to jump and dance. One of them was pushed to the crusade on a wheelbarrow, and the other, a young girl, came hobbling on crutches. In addition to this, a good number of deaf people were healed, and many others were healed from different diseases and infirmities.

Every night, there was a hunger for the Gospel evident. The crowds during this crusade were amazing; this in contrast to our last crusade in Tafara when many rowdy people physically attacked us. Our team had to literally fight them just to protect themselves.

I remember one man who was so extremely violent that he continued trying to fight us even after we physically subdued him and tied him with a thick rope in order to hand him over to the police. At the end of the crusade, this same man returned and gave his life to Jesus!

A couple of years ago he contacted us and told us that he was now in the ministry, and the Pastor of a Pentecostal church!

This time it was very different. The people were respectful; we had no trouble from the crowd at any point during the week. They stood quietly as the Gospel was preached, listening intently. Conviction came over their hearts, and night after night, we saw masses of people respond to the Gospel and give their lives to Jesus.

Since it is winter in the Southern Hemisphere, it was cold. Many people did not have adequate footwear or warm clothing. In spite of this, they came out to hear the Gospel. Since

there were so many without proper clothing, I went to town and bought new clothes and shoes for some of the street kids.

There was one little boy that God healed from deafness. He was barefoot and in rags. My heart went out to him, and the next day we dressed him up in new clothes.

After he was dressed up they brought him to me. I looked at him and a big smile hit his face; it was like the smile on the face of an angel; absolutely priceless. I turned away so that no one would see me cry, and I thought to myself, "If I came all the way to Zimbabwe just for this little kid, it is worth it all!"

It was at that moment when I heard the voice of the Lord speak to me loud and clear, "This is the purpose of prosperity! Not to live a life full of self-indulgence, but to save sinners, to heal the sick, and to put smiles on the faces of people like these who have nothing! This, my Son, is what it is all about!"

I thought of times when some of my fellow preachers have said that I was against prosperity just because I have not been quiet about my distaste of today's popular culture of greed, self-indulgence, and selfish lifestyles. That is what I'm against; not biblical

prosperity! Biblical prosperity is when God blesses us so that we can be a blessing to others!

This is why our ministry is blessed, and why we are able to use the resources God has given us to bring multitudes of souls to Jesus every year.

Throughout the week, the Lord also gave great grace and confirmed His Word with many signs, wonders, and miracles. We saw many deaf ears and blind eyes opened, and crippled people got up and began to walk, jump, and run. In addition to this, many testified to being healed from various diseases and other to tumors that disappeared.

On the last night, God poured out His Spirit in a mighty way and thousands were baptized with the Holy Ghost and with Fire; speaking in other tongues, shouting, and praising God. Also, a multitude was healed
