Gospel Breakthrough in Rimuka!

Dear Friends,

In this newsletter, I am reporting on our recent crusade in Rimuka, the largest township of the city of Kadoma which is located in central Zimbabwe.

The local churches responded with great enthusiasm. Many believers from these congregations committed themselves to the Mobile Bible School, our pre-crusade training program. Once a crusade event ends, it is those who have participated in the training program that visit the homes of new converts to disciple them and help them get absorbed into the local churches.

Our Africa team, led by Pastor Mavondo, did a great job in preparing the churches for the crusade. After visiting our church planters in Asia, I

flew to Zimbabwe to find everything prepared and ready to go. Everyone was excited and fully anticipating the great things that the Lord would do in their lives and in their town.

The weather was bitterly cold. The days were a bit cool, but the nighttime temperatures dipped to just above freezing. It was the coldest recorded winter in a hundred years. In spite of this, the people came out to the crusade in huge numbers; I was touched to see their hunger for the Gospel.

In addition to the abnormally low temperatures, there were long and frequent electric shutdowns as a result of the dire economic situation in Zimbabwe. Many evenings as we drove into Rimuka we found the entire town shrouded in darkness.

The electrical outages did not affect us since we use a generator to operate our equipment. However, it was tough for the local people; they had to cook their evening meals using very poor quality firewood. The use of this firewood covered the entire town with a pall of thick, pungent smoke.

The smoke made visibility extremely limited – you can see evidence of this in the cloudy and dark crowd photo on the front page of this newsletter. The smoke also made our eyes water and inhaling it induced heavy coughing. This made preaching very difficult; nevertheless, we pressed on!

The first night of the crusade began with a powerful move of God; a huge crowd was present to hear the Gospel. As the Word of God went forth that night, one could sense great conviction setting into the hearts of the people. A

multitude responded to the altar call for salvation. After the altar call, the Lord confirmed His Word with many signs, wonders, and miracles.

Here are a few of the wonderful testimonies from that first night: A paralyzed woman, who was unable to walk and was carried to the crusade in a wheelbarrow, was touched by the power of Jesus. She praised God as she got up and began to walk and run!

There was a woman, crippled after a traffic accident, who with great difficulty dragged herself to the crusade using a staff. When Jesus touched her she stood straight up, threw down her staff, and began to run and dance as she praised God. In addition to this, there were deaf people healed, and many others healed from various diseases and infirmities.

The presence of the Lord was over us each night of the crusade. On the second night with an even larger crowd present, another multitude of people responded to the Gospel to be saved. God's miracle working power began to flow, and one of the first miracles of the night was the healing of a totally blind man.

Then a woman testified that Jesus touched her and a large tumor on her breast had disappeared. A man with

many tumors around his neck and throat was healed, and the tumors disappeared in an instant! These are just a few of the many things that the Lord did that night.

The Lord continued to manifest His presence, bringing multitudes of people to salvation every night and confirming His Word with signs, wonders, and miracles.

One night, a man came to the crusade carrying his seven-month-old baby. He had been at our crusade in the nearby town of Chegutu the week before. The baby was born with a clubfoot causing the left foot to be totally twisted and turned so that the sole of the foot faced upward.

In addition to this, the baby's leg was also twisted and paralyzed. God healed the baby; the leg and foot are now straight and totally normal. This man traveled to Kadoma just to show us what the Lord had done!

On Friday night, two paralyzed people who had been carried to the crusade in wheelbarrows got up, and began walking, running, and praising God. After that, there was a well known and dedicated Christian schoolteacher whose legs had become paralyzed some years back. She could not stand or walk and as a result had to give up teaching.

God touched this school teacher and raised her up by His power. With tears flowing down her cheeks she shouted profusely, praising God with all her heart, and began to run and jump all over the place. When she came up to the platform to testify, she could barely speak. She simply cried as she jumped up and down praising God, and the whole crowd rejoiced and shouted with her.

Among all the wonderful things that the Lord was doing, one night there was a very interesting miracle. There was a boy brought to the crusade by his older brother who could not stand up or walk. He was not paralyzed, but he was born without any sense of balance. As a result, whenever he would try to stand up he would immediately fall to the ground. Jesus healed him, and he began to walk and run all over the platform to the cheers of the rejoicing crowd!

Every night, we saw God heal many deaf ears. Blind people were healed, and many others were healed from various diseases and infirmities.

On the last night of the crusade, the Holy Ghost fell upon the crowd with Pentecostal power. Thousands were baptized with the Holy Ghost and with Fire, speaking in other tongues,

shouting, falling to the ground, shaking, and praising God.

In conjunction with the crusade, we held a School of Ministry that was attended by approximately 300 pastors. A friend of mine, Pastor David Newberry, joined me in ministering and the event went very well. I taught on 'The present-day ministry of Jesus Christ.' God touched the delegates' hearts in a deep way. Many people were greatly affected and we received many positive testimonies from them.

At least nine pastors attending the School of Ministry came to me and shared that they had been saved during past crusades. It touched me to meet these men of God and to look into their eyes and realize that each one of them had come to our crusades as sinners; they heard the Gospel, gave their lives to Jesus, and today are engaged in fruitful ministry for our Lord.

I share this with you, our friends and partners, those who love us, pray for us, and support this



ministry financially. Please know that everything you and I have done in the service of the Gospel of our Lord Jesus has born and will continue to bear very rich fruit unto the glory of God. These nine are just a few of the many ministers that I have met through the years who have said that they first met Jesus during one of our crusades.

All glory to the Lord Jesus!

We shall hold two more crusades in Zimbabwe before the end of the year. At the last of these crusades, we will also hold a School of Ministry and we are expecting around 1,000 pastors to attend.

Presently, there is a great shortage of food in Zimbabwe. Drinking water is hard to find. Basic things like bread, meat, and chicken are almost impossible to get. We believe that we should help the attending pastors and feed them good meals during the School of Ministry. Many of them do not get enough to eat and subsist on one meager meal a day. We desire to be a blessing to them, and are in the process of buying bulls and chickens from the countryside for this purpose. It is a very expensive enterprise, and if the Lord puts it in your heart to help if this effort simply give as the Lord leads you. It will be a great blessing to provide meals for these pastors!

Before the end of the year I shall also be going to an undisclosed area of Asia for a crusade and a School of Ministry for pastors. In addition to this, we have meetings scheduled in Taiwan and Thailand.

How wonderful and exciting it is to serve our Lord Jesus!
