## Chazanga Crusade and Burma Relief Effort

Dear Friends,

In this newsletter, I am reporting about our recent crusade held in Chazanga, in Zambia. In addition to this, I am also giving a report about our relief efforts to help the people that were affected by the cyclone that recently devastated much of the coastal region of Burma.

### The Chazanga Crusade:

Chazanga is a very poor town located about 30 minutes away from Lusaka the capital city of Zambia. It is a place in great need of the Gospel. It is rife with crime, prostitution, and witchcraft. In fact, most crimes in Lusaka are committed by residents of Chazanga. The poverty there is appalling. Seventy percent of the houses in Chazanga have no electricity, sewage or water supply.

Pastor Mavondo (*of Zimbabwe*) our Director of Operations for Africa was away in Australia where his wife Loreen, who is working on her PhD, was giving birth to their first child, a little baby girl named Nyasha – here is a

new name for you Lancaster County people! In his absence our crusade team was ably led by Assistant Team Leader, Janey Menzies (*of Scotland*).

Chazanga was “cooking” by the time I got there. A large crowd had gathered at the crusade ground for the first service. Now, I have been to some really bad places and preached to really unruly crowds, but I must say that the crowds in Chazanga were some of the most rowdy people that I have ever preached to. There were drunks and people strung out on drugs, street thugs and criminals who just wanted to make trouble and fight with us, and lots of “ordinary” people who just came to disrupt things as much as they possibility could.

I had decided to preach the Gospel and to let nothing stop us, and I did. Those who were violent we dealt with physically and strongly with “tough love.” After we had dealt with them we handed them over to the police who were only happy to receive the town’s thugs in their custody.

The preaching of the Gospel and the miracles that followed the preaching brought great conviction upon the people, and the crowds grew every night. In every service, we saw huge multitudes receive the Lord Jesus. Street criminals, prostitutes, gangsters, and all

kinds of people came to hear the Gospel and were saved. The pastors in town were excited to see this great harvest of souls brought in before their very eyes. Their churches had been trained by our team to follow up on the new believers, and they were ready to get to this task with gusto and enthusiasm.

The Lord did amazing miracles in our midst; many deaf ears were opened, blind people received their sight, paralyzed people were healed, and many demon-possessed people were delivered!

On the last night of the crusade, the Holy Ghost fell with great power. Thousands of people received the baptism with the Holy Ghost and with Fire. Thus ended the Chazanga crusade; in victory and with much glory and praises being given unto God. The Spirit of the Lord had broken through with great power and Chazanga was gripped by Jesus! All Glory to Jesus for all that He has done!

This is why we preach the Gospel, *"This shall be written for the generation to come: and the people which shall be created shall praise the LORD. For he hath looked down from the height of his sanctuary; from heaven did the LORD behold the earth; To hear the groaning of the prisoner; to loose those that are appointed to death; To declare the name of the LORD."* Psalm 102:18-21

### Burma Relief Operations:

I am sure you have heard of the recent cyclone (Hurricane) that devastated the Irrawaddy Delta Region of Burma. As per "official" figures at least 100,000 people died and millions lost everything and were left homeless. I was in Burma two days before the cyclone hit. As soon as it happened, our missionary in Thailand, Scott Fletcher, and I tried hard to contact Brother W, our director in Burma. It was impossible, because all phone lines, electric power and internet connections were down for an entire week.

Rangoon airport was closed for days and when it opened, the Burmese authorities

were not letting any foreigners in. I was in Africa by then, and my main concern was Brother W, his family, and our churches in the affected area. We had no news of them and I was trying hard all day and night to get a call through.

Finally, one day, I just broke down and cried. That is when the Lord spoke to me and assured me that "everything would be all right." By then, I had sent out e-mails to friends asking for help and people began to send in funds to help. We finally heard from Brother W, and I

Anna Kakwasha, 57, was blind and saw nothing but blackness with both eyes. Jesus opened her eyes and she can now see perfectly!

Jesus healed Irene Nguni, 50, who was completely deaf in one ear. Now she can see!

Paul Banda, 50, had a tumor in his head for 6 months. Jesus healed him and the tumor disappeared!

Edward Mwanza, 62, was partially blind (he was legally blind) and could not see anything properly, even from 3 feet away. Jesus healed him and gave him perfect sight!



instructed him to fly to Bangkok to give a full report of the damage.

Ten of our 128 churches that we have planted in Burma were in the Delta region and were affected. By God's grace nobody from our churches was killed although a few people were injured slightly. The buildings rented and used by our churches were destroyed as were the homes of our church members.

We immediately released thousands of dollars from the funds for our training center and sent four teams of our pastors and church-planters to help the people. I have a friend, a physician living in Burma who has been preparing for an eventuality like this for ten years. He immediately started relief operations and we sent two teams led by a registered nurse to help him. Our other two teams are working with our churches in the affected areas. In addition to this, we have more teams standing by to help my friend if he needs them.

There are over a hundred small private orphanages that are being helped by my physician friend, and our teams are busy helping him with this. We are doing all this at great risk because it must be done, and we appreciate your prayers and support in this. We have so far received and sent \$ 76,000. We are providing

medical aid, shelter, clothing, footwear and full rations for one full month for all our church members in the affected areas. In addition to this, we are drilling ten wells in the communities where our affected churches are located, to provide fresh water for the communities there.

Because of the situation of Burma, most people have sent in funds for Burma, and we find ourselves falling short on funds for our operations in Africa. We need funds for our crusades, team salaries, food, and fuel costs. Prices have skyrocketed and we need over \$5,300 for diesel alone for each set of two crusades.

Most people have sent in funds for Burma, even funds that they would normally contribute towards our Africa crusades. Because of this, funds for our crusade operations have been depleted. We need funds for our crusades, staff and to offset the skyrocketing prices of food and diesel fuel in Africa. Please do stand with us,

with your generous support, as the Lord would put in your heart to do. Thank you for your love, faithful prayers, and financial support for the work of the Gospel through our ministry!
