Gospel Harvest in Mandebyu



Dear Friends,

Mandebvu is a very poor high-crime township outside the capital city of Lusaka, Zambia. This was the chosen venue for this crusade. The town had a very bad reputation; but then, it is precisely places such as these where the people need Jesus so much. Only He can bring them out of darkness and give them Life!

On the way out to Africa, we stopped in Thailand and Singapore. In Thailand, we had a rendezvous with Pastor William our Director of Operations in Asia. He reported that our churches are doing well, thriving and growing.

Brother William also reported that so many people came to Jesus through our Cyclone Relief Operations that our teams planted six more churches in the affected areas. In addition to that, one of our churches which is a fast-growing congregation planted four

more churches. This brings the total number of churches planted through our ministry in Asia to 152.

I am writing this to thank and encourage those of you who have been sowing your finances, faith, and prayers into our work in Asia. Much fruit is being borne on your account to the Glory of God!

After Thailand, we went to Singapore where I preached at an Assembly of God church. I also preached at an outreach to the Hindu community where sixty people came forward to receive Jesus at the meeting.

From there we flew straight down to Africa.

The Mandebvu Crusade:

The evenings were very cold and chilly, but huge crowds came out to hear the Gospel in every service. The crowds were swelling every night and huge multitudes were responding to the altar call during each service and were receiving the Lord Jesus. The crowd was extremely rowdy and noisy on the first two nights, and very rough characters were picking fights with our team during the service.

One of our men was attacked with a knife or sharpened screwdriver and got away with only a scratch on his arm. We managed to subdue the attackers and handed them to the police. In situations like this, it is best to just to keep preaching hard. This I did, and the Spirit of the Lord broke through the darkness on the third night. After that, it was much more peaceful.

We saw the Mighty Hand of God move in Mandebvu. God confirmed His Word with signs, wonders, and miracles. Jesus opened deaf ears every night. Paralyzed limbs were

healed, and we saw several people who were almost fully blind receive their sight. In addition to this, many with other diseases and infirmities were also healed.

Many children were also Saved in the children's crusade that Janey and her team of volunteers held in the afternoons.

This is what Janey writes: "Thousands of children lifted their hands and prayed to receive Jesus as Lord and Saviour. Although some don't understand what they are doing, there are many that are touched by God and their lives will never be the same. Quantifying our effectiveness is impossible; we don't know the real impact we have had but we do know that God's word does not return void, but it must perform what it has been sent to do. Praise the Lord for his faithfulness."

It rained on two of the last three nights of the crusade and I preached with my clothes soaked. But, the people were just so hungry for the Gospel that thousands stood in the rain and the biting cold to hear the message. We saw multitudes come to Jesus and God gave great Grace, confirming His Word with signs following.

One most outstanding miracle that took place in this crusade was the raising of a

dead woman. Her married daughter came and told us this testimony:

She lived in a house close to the field where the crusade was being held, and her mother lived with them. They received news that her oldest sibling, who lived in Zimbabwe, had died. Upon receiving this

news, her mother collapsed with either a brain hemorrhage or a severe stroke, and was left totally paralyzed and unable to speak. A couple of days later, she died.

Family members came from afar and gathered at the house to see the body, to mourn, and to make funeral arrangements. They were all crying and mourning that evening. At the same time, they could also hear me preaching in the distance at our crusade.

Then, the family heard me pray for the sick. The daughter said, "When Pastor Christopher began to pray for the paralyzed and said 'Lord, send your Life and your Healing Virtue into the paralyzed bodies in Jesus Name!' life suddenly came into my dead mother and she sat up. She came back to life and stood up! She began to speak, and then went to the bathroom and took a shower, and ate afterwards!"

This is what our Lord Jesus can do! He is the Savior of the lost, the Healer of the sick, and the Deliverer of the oppressed. His is the Name that is above every other name! Even death has to loose its grip when we call upon that Wonderful and Mighty Name of our Lord Jesus! Hallelujah!

On the last night of the crusade, the field was packed with a sea of humanity

and we saw a massive response to the altar call with a huge multitude receiving Jesus.

Then, we prayed for the Baptism with the Holy Ghost and with Fire. The Fire of the Lord fell upon the multitude and thousands upon thousands were Baptized with the Holy Ghost and with Fire, speaking in other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance. Tear-stained African faces worshipping Jesus; people falling, shouting, and weeping all over the place...

So ended our first Africa Crusade for 2009! *All Glory to our Lord Jesus!*



People can believe in Jesus only if the hear. They can only hear if a preacher preaches to them.


A preacher can only preach if he is sent.
