## Breaking News From Zimbabwe!

A couple of years ago, a Pentecostal denomination with churches in Zimbabwe, Mozambique, Botswana, and South Africa approached me, asking me to be their leader. They wanted to work under our ministry and merge with us. We have had discussions with them for some time and now it has happened. We have signed the necessary legal papers and it is done. I shall be holding a Leadership and Vision Conference with the main Regional Leaders "our" new churches during our crusade in Victoria Falls. I shall take time to teach and to encourage them, share my heart and also spell out the vision and the direction in which we are going.

These past couple of weeks, our Africa team has been out ministering in some of our main churches. From the reports that I have received, revival has broken loose and there is tremendous excitement for this new journey that we are stepping into together.

This denomination that is now under us owns a very large farm of over 1000 acres. It is so big that it has its own airstrip! This is prime farmland that was purchased (NOT seized like white-owned farms were by the government) from a white farmer who had decided to leave Zimbabwe many years ago.

My plan is to develop the farm, and to start an orphanage and a Church Planting School

there. The goal is that the income from the farm should, in the long run, support both the orphanage and the Church Planting School. Then, after that, we shall also start a school to teach local farmers both farming skills and the repair and maintenance of farm equipment.

My dream is to develop the Church Planting School to the point that students from Europe and the United States shall come to learn how to hold crusades and plant churches with Signs, Wonders, and Miracles, under the Power of the Holy Ghost.

For this, we shall need much help. The first thing I am asking you, my friends, is for you to share your thoughts and ideas. We need contacts with organizations that help farming projects in Africa. We also need contacts with organizations that donate new or refurbished tractors, combines, plows and other agricultural equipment to projects such as this. I am fundamentally a soul-winner and church-planter and have never engaged in projects such as this. So, I need all the advice, pointers, and contacts that I can get!

Although I must confess that I know very little about farming, our Director of Operations in Africa, Pastor Mavondo, has a University Degree in Agriculture and he owns and runs his own farm. What a Blessing!

Initially, we will need funding for boreholes/wells/pumps for irrigation and to put up some necessary buildings, etc. We will need work/construction teams to go and help us with the buildings. After that, we will need funds for the orphanage and for the Church Planting School to get these projects going.

This being in place we will need qualified long-term and short-term volunteers to go out as missionaries. We will need people who can teach the Word of God, those with management and bookkeeping capabilities, those with knowledge of agriculture, mechanics, qualified children's workers, etc.

This is an exciting challenge that we have before us, and I believe that the Lord is in this. This entire project, once it is up and running can bring great blessing to many people!

Let us pray and stand in Faith together for this endeavor!

## Crusade Report Mbare-Rufaro

In this Newsletter, I am reporting from our crusade in Mbare-Rufaro in the outskirts of Harare, Zimbabwe. Rufaro is the farthest end of the widely-spread township of Mbare. It is a small area, but with great spiritual needs.

The local churches asked us to come and hold a crusade there. It was to be a small but necessary crusade and we decided to touch Mbare-Rufaro the week before our main crusade in Mbare-Stoddart, right in the center of Mbare.

It was winter in Africa and, as such, was very cold in the evenings, just a few degrees above freezing – certainly not the ideal situation for an open-air crusade. Yet, in spite of this and the people's lack of adequate winter clothing, thousands came out to hear the Gospel and to receive the Lord Jesus. God confirmed His Word with many wonderful miracles.

Here is an excerpt from our mid-crusade report: "So far we have seen the Lord open deaf ears every night, last night a girl with a paralyzed arm was healed. Some with severely impaired eyesight and a boy who could not see with one eye have been healed. A

lady who had a large cancer testified how God had healed her and that the thing had disappeared. Several others, who had great difficulties walking, ran and leaped for Joy. What a wonderful Jesus we serve! All Glory to Him alone who is worthy!"

On the last night of the crusade, I preached from 1 Corinthians 1:18, "For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness, but unto us which are saved it is the power of God."

The crowd was rowdy, noisy, criminal, street thugs with containers of alcohol that they were drinking out of.

I began to tell them how a Man who died upon a Cross outside Jerusalem 2000 years ago changed the life of a young Muslim man like me 2000 years later.


Referring to a little boy who was born totally deaf in both ears and had been healed in front of them, I told them that because of the death of a Man who died upon a wooden Cross outside Jerusalem 2000 years ago, a little boy born deaf in Zimbabwe 2000 years later received his hearing before their very eyes.

I brought up several such examples: a lady with cancer and a boy blind in one eye, both healed before their eyes. I pointed to a pastor sitting on the platform who once was a drunkard and smoked dope, as to how he was a man of God today because of one Man who died upon a Cross outside of Jerusalem 2000 years ago.

That really got them; the crowd quieted down and listened respectfully and intently. One could hear a pin drop. Great conviction

came upon the people; and then at the altar call, thousands responded seeking the Savior, the One whose Life and whose Death are mighty to save sinners and heal the sick even today.

That is why we preach the Cross of Jesus, because the Power of the death of Jesus of Nazareth upon that Cross 2000 years ago can change people's lives even today! This is what it is all about! The Gospel is the Story of the Death, the Resurrection, and the Soon Coming of our Lord Jesus. There is power in this wonderful Gospel to bring conviction that grips the hearts of sinners and makes them aware of their sinful state, and literally compels them to come to Jesus.

What a privilege it is to serve Jesus!

Every night, we saw thousands of people brave the cold weather and come out to hear the Gospel; and every night we were blessed to see thousands receive Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior. We saw God do many miracles in our midst.

On that last night, we heard lots of testimonies.... A young boy brought his little cousin who was born deaf. He came with great faith and expectancy in his heart, and was not disappointed. Jesus healed his little cousin. A young man with AIDS, his

body racked with great pain and his legs severely swollen described how all his pain and other outwards symptoms disappeared and his legs went back to normal.

A lady then testified that she had heard of the crusade and traveled over 200 miles to attend; she had a tumor growing on her breast that had instantly disappeared. Another lady whose legs had been partially paralyzed danced for joy after the Lord healed her. There was a moment of great hilarity when a little boy who for months could only move with great difficulty after a leg injury danced demonstrating some of his "fancy footwork". He was good!

Many others testified of the wonderful things that the Lord had done for them. Then the Holy Ghost fell upon the multitude and many were Baptized with the Holy Ghost and with Fire.

For all things, we give all the glory, honor and praise to our Lord Jesus!


That is why we preach the Cross of Jesus, because the Power of the death

of Jesus of Nazareth upon that Cross could change people's lives today!






He was blind in one eye, but can now see!




This boy, who could barely walk for many months after a severe leg injury, shows off his dancing skills.




A lady, who had a cancerous tumor that disappeared, leaves the platform dancing!
