# Pentecostal Flames Fall Over Chawama!

Greetings in Jesus Name!

In this newsletter, I would like to report on our recent crusade held in the township of Chawama, Zambia.

We had been to Chawama before, and the churches had experienced much growth as a result of our crusades there. Our team prepared the crusade well, working together with the local churches. It was, therefore, with much anticipation that a huge multitude came out to the crusade on the opening night. They braved the cold weather to stand for hours, singing, dancing with us, and listening to the Gospel message. I preached from John 3:14-17. The huge multitude responded wholeheartedly to the altar call and gave their hearts to Jesus.

After that the Lord did many wonderful miracles. Amongst other things many deaf ears were opened and a lady with a large tumor inside her mouth testified to how the tumor instantly disappeared under the Power of God. Another lady testified that she was practically blind (she could only see a blurry couple of feet in front of her). Jesus healed her and gave her perfect sight. After this many others also testified of what the Lord had done for them. It was a wonderful beginning to this crusade!

Helping my team and me in this crusade, were 18 members from Victory Family Church in Cranberry Township, PA, the students of the Gospel Training Institute in Lusaka, and some friends from Sweden and Switzerland. They were all a great help in ministering to the sick at the

crusade and ministering at the Children's Crusade in the afternoon.

The power of our Lord continued to flow at the Chawama Crusade. The Lord continued to manifest His Grace as large masses of people gave their lives to the Lord Jesus every night. Salvation flowed like a mighty flood during this crusade, with masses of people coming under conviction and giving their lives to Jesus every night.

We saw the Lord do many wonderful miracles. Blind people received their sight, many deaf ears were opened, crippled people walked, people were healed from many different diseases and infirmities, and they came to testify of what the Lord had done for them. Every night we saw demon-possessed people fall to the

ground screaming and the devils coming out of them, because of the power of the wonderful Name of our Lord Jesus.

Surely, our Lord Jesus is the same yesterday, today and forever! What a wonderful Savior we serve; all Glory to Him for all things, because He alone is Worthy!

A huge multitude had gathered on the final night of the crusade. It was what we call "Holy Ghost Night": where we usually pray for people to receive the baptism with the Holy Ghost and Fire on the final night of every crusade.

I preached about the Blood of our Lord Jesus. I always do this on "Holy Ghost Night" because I know that the Blood always brings down the Glory. God always answers the Blood with Fire! In the Bible the Fire of God never fell upon dry altars, but always upon Blood-soaked altars. If we want the Fire of God to fall, we must sing, shout and preach about the Cross and the Blood of our Lord Jesus!

The response to the altar call for Salvation was fantastic. People all over the field and those standing across the road wanted to receive the Lord Jesus.

After that, the Fire of the Lord fell with Pentecostal Power. Thousands upon thousands were baptized with the Holy Ghost and with Fire. Beautiful, tear-stained, African faces were turned up towards Heaven, worshiping God in other tongues, their shouts and praises ascending to the very Throne of God. The Lord responded by unleashing wave upon wave of his Glory upon the gathered multitude. All the way to the back of the huge crowd, the whole field seemed ablaze with the Fire of God.

Then the Lord healed the sick and the infirm. Deaf ears were opened,

people's eyes were healed, and tumors disappeared. One lady testified that a huge fibroid tumor the size of an orange had completely vanished from her as Jesus touched her. Another young lady, crippled and unable to walk was carried to the crusade in on a wheelbarrow; Jesus touched her and she walked and danced upon the platform, pushing her wheelbarrow in front of her as the crowd cheered and shouted with boundless joy. Also, a young man, paralyzed and unable to walk, got up and walked.

My dear friend, Pastor John Nuzzo, of Victory Family Church of Cranberry Township, PA, stood alongside me. I am glad that he could see the fruit of all the generous support that his church has been giving us all these years.

Such was the end of this crusade. During the week, we had been up upon the mountaintops of victory, but also in the valley of sorrow at the death of the son of our fellow brother, Pastor Zulu. This young man was at the crusade and after the end of one of the services, had stepped in to intervene and bring peace in a fight between some people. One of the men fighting took out a knife and stabbed Pastor Zulu's son, who was killed instantly. John Nuzzo, Pastor Mavondo and I visited Pastor Zulu's home and prayed with them. We also paid for the funeral to help alleviate the financial burden upon the grieving family.

Yet in spite of such things, we know that in

all things we are more than conquerors through Him who has loved us. The Lord is Faithful and True. Pastor Zulu's son today in is in Heaven with Jesus, but he left behind the testimony of a young man who loved God. Especially poignant for me, is the fact that Pastor Zulu was saved at one of our crusades here in Zambia many years ago. There are so many pastors and evangelists in Africa who received Salvation in our Crusades through the years. It is a privilege to serve the Lord alongside them, to share their victories and even to weep with them in their sorrows.

May the Lord find us all faithful, serving Him with Faith, in Love, and with the Fire of the Holy Ghost!






A 15 year-old deaf-mute girl hears and speaks for the first time ever.






An orange-sized fibroid tumor disappeared.




A boy totally blind in one eye receives his sight.

Mutala Mwanda, 18, was deaf since birth. Jesus healed him, and he can now hear!


Bridget Phiri, 17, was deaf since she was a baby. Jesus healed her, and she can now hear!
