The Power of the Gospel in Glenview, Zimbabwe!



Dear Friends,

Greetings in Jesus Name!

In this newsletter, I would like to report from our recent crusade held in the township of Glenview in Zimbabwe. This crusade was well-prepared by our Africa Team led by Pastor Nicholas Mavondo, working together with the local churches in Glenview.

For three weeks, our team worked hard running our Pre-Crusade Mobile Bible School for the local churches. During this time, they trained those who would serve as workers during the crusade itself and would also carry on with follow-up ministry amongst the new converts immediately following the crusade.

Follow-up ministry consists of workers

visiting the addresses on each decision card, ministering to and discipling the new believers in their homes and getting them into a nearby local church.

September is supposed to be a warm month in Zimbabwe. This time, however, the days were very warm but the temperature dropped very sharply at sunset so the evenings turned extremely cold and chilly. We were blessed to see multitudes of people brave the elements to come out to hear the Gospel in spite of the very cold weather.

The crowds grew every night, and they respectfully listened as the Gospel was preached. We were blessed to see a huge harvest of souls come to Jesus every night.

In accordance with the New Testament pattern, we saw the Lord pour out His

Grace every night with signs, wonders, and miracles following the preaching of the Gospel Message. Every night, we saw the Lord open the ears of the deaf. We also saw tumors disappear from people's bodies.

One of these was a lady who had a huge tumor inside her throat that prevented her from being able to speak. She was scheduled for surgery the next week on September 24th and the tumor would then be removed. But, Jesus healed her. The tumor disappeared completely and she began to speak perfectly!

Another day, a teenage girl who was demon possessed was carried in by her family. Because of this demon possession she had become paralyzed and mute, unable to walk and unable to speak.

Jesus set her completely free. In front of the cheering and shouting multitude she walked, ran, and spoke perfectly! All Glory to Jesus!

In addition to this, we saw many other miracles such as people with severely impaired vision receive perfect sight. Others who could not walk without crutches, were partially paralyzed, or unable to walk freely were healed. They gladly testified of what the Lord had done for them; leaping, running, and dancing for joy as they came to testify!

On the last night, we saw several thousand receive the Baptism with the Holy Ghost and with Fire. The crusade ended with expressions of great joy – with much singing, dancing, and rejoicing by the multitudes from Glenview who had come to the final service.

What a Mighty God we serve! What a Wonderful Savior our Lord Jesus is! Glory to His Name for ever!

The needs in Zimbabwe are very great. They need food, medical equipment, and anything else that the international community could donate and provide. We as a ministry have already brought tons of food into the country and stand ready to bring in anything else that people may donate for those in need.

But, the greatest need of all, above all things, is the people's desperate need of the Gospel of Jesus. *"...Man doth not live by bread only, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of the LORD doth man live."* (Deuteronomy 8:3). These words were spoken by God thousands of years ago; these are Words so potent and powerful that our Lord Jesus Himself quoted this Scripture to fend off the Satan's attack upon Him in Matthew 4:4.

These Words stand true even today. People do need humanitarian help and food, but most of all they need Jesus. They need the Word of God. They need Faith, the kind of Faith in our Living God that can turn every situation and every adversity around in the favor of the one who believes and puts his trust in Him. This Faith can change one's eternal destiny; it can raise a man up from his deathbed. It can bring deliverance. It can put food upon one's table when a man is hungry. It can do all things!

In our ministry, we do make efforts to bring different kinds of help to people in need. Right now, we are working together with Christian friends who desire to start a much needed orphanage in Zimbabwe.

In addition to this, with the generous financial aid of our friends and partners, we were recently able to relocate an entire congregation of new believers in Asia. These precious brethren had paid a terrible price for their faith after they had been attacked and their homes had been destroyed. Their pastor's wife had been gang-raped and all the Christians had been thrown out of the village. We relocated the entire congregation to another area and built homes for all the families.

We do stand up to help those in need, but foremost and above things all we are Soul Winners and Church Planters. God has called us to *"Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature"* (Mark 16:15).

The task that we have at hand is great, and in the words of our Lord Jesus, *"The harvest truly is plenteous..."* (Matthew 9:37).

No matter what, we have this very clear commandment from our Lord Jesus Himself, to go out and preach the gospel. This is something that we cannot shirk from; but we have to put our hand on the plow and not look back but press on ahead – no matter what it may cost us.

This calling to preach the gospel, make disciples, and to help those in need is the very reason for what we call "Biblical Prosperity." The very principle of giving and receiving multiplied blessings, of sowing and then reaping 30 60 or 100 fold, is that we may be empowered and enabled to use the blessings and the material provisions that God bestows upon us to reach a lost and dying world with the love and the power of our Lord Jesus Christ.

We have seen during this year and the last year, during these times of economic crisis, how many of you, our friends and partners, have risen above and beyond your own needs and have sacrificed above and beyond your normal ability in order to make sure that the Gospel went out unhindered

to those who needed it. So many have even sacrificed and done without luxuries that you have perhaps desired in order to help us spread the Gospel out. You and your partners inspire us, and you cause us to press on even farther than we

I'm writing this newsletter to you in Zimbabwe, where we are starting more Gospel Crusades in Zimbabwe. We are grateful to the Lord that you are our partners and friends. We are able to fulfill our vision of Gospel Crusades in Africa.

In December, I shall be in Asia for a crusade, along with a School of Pastors of our 168 churches.

Thank you for standing aloft for not giving up or backing down. Immense Courage and, at times, sacrifice.

Let us give all the Glory, Honor, and Praise to our Lord Jesus who enable us to fulfill the calling to "Preach the Gospel to every creature!"




A young man runs without his crutch after God healed him!




He could barely move without help, but now he can walk!





