Never Lose the Sweetness of your Communion with Him

When I was new in Pentecostal and Faith ministry, one of my mentors was Pastor Harry Greenwood from South Chard, England. He came to Sweden very often and had a great impact upon the churches there. I have never seen the Gifts of the Holy Ghost and Miracles flow through anyone as they did through Harry Greenwood. I was blessed to have this amazing and very loving man of God speak into my life until he went to be with the Lord in 1989.

It was in Ljungskile in Sweden in July 1986 that he said to me at the dinner table: "You can come a point in your ministry where you reach a certain level in your Faith and you learn the ways of the Flow of the Gifts of the Holy Spirit, and just stay there. You can lose your communion and the freshness of your daily walk with the Lord, and still see miracles because you have settled at that level of Faith and you have learned the distinctive ways in which the Spirit moves through His Gifts. People think that you have a wonderful ministry because they see the miracles, but what they cannot see is that inside you are actually dried up and dead, because you have lost the Sweetness of your Communion with God. NEVER let that happen to you!"

It was a life-changing moment for me, it was one of those things that I have never forgotten.

Miracles and the Gifts of the Holy Ghost are wonderful, and the Bible does exhort us to "Covet earnestly the best gifts". But even more important is to maintain the freshness and the sweetness of our communion with our Lord.

Focus: Africa Crusades

MEET OUR TEAM


Our team currently consists of 5 individuals: Pastor Nicholas Mavondo (*Zimbabwean*) is the Director of Operations in Africa, Farai Chifamba (*Zimbabwean*) is in charge of the finances and bookkeeping, Brighton (*Zimbabwean*) is our music and worship leader, Patrick (*Zambian*) is our electric engineer, and our newest member Joseph Shereni (*Zimbabwean*) is our sound engineer and also leads our children's crusades.

GOSPEL CRUSADES

We typically hold 10 Gospel crusades each year. In most cases, we hold double crusades where two crusades are run back to back in nearby towns. The first crusade begins Tuesday and ends Sunday. During the following two days the team transitions to the next location, and the final crusade begins Wednesday and ends Sunday of the second week.

While there are a lot of preparations that take place prior to arriving at the crusade location, the official on site preparations begin 3 weeks prior to the beginning of the crusade. It is at that time that we launch our Mobile Bible School.

We coordinate with the local churches to participate with at the crusade in their town many months in advance. The leaders and member of these





churches attend our Mobile Bible School where we prepare and equip them as individuals and congregations to disciple the new believers that have resulted from the crusade.

Regularly coinciding with our crusades, we hold Children's Crusades in the afternoons with thousands of children attending and hearing the Gospel message in a way that is relevant to them. Additionally, Schools of Ministry are held several times a year to equip leaders and pastors.

We see tens of thousands receiving Salvation every night as they receive Jesus Christ as their Lord and Saviour. And, we continually see God confirm His Word with signs, wonders, and miracles. Finally, each crusade closes with the opportunity for people to be baptized with the Holy Ghost and with Fire!

GET INVOLVED


1. **Prayer:** Partner with us through prayer!
