God's Calling

What is God's Calling Over Your Life?

If you are trying to figure out what God's Calling over your life is, I would give the following advice:

Firstly, begin to serve God in your local church in whatever opportunity is given or is offered to you, even if it is something very minor in your eyes. Be faithful and say to yourself, "Lord, if this is the greatest thing that I shall ever do in my life, I shall be faithful to it, and do it with joy!"

As you show yourself faithful, God will open other opportunities for you. First it will be serving in "natural" things, and then in opportunities to share the Word of God with people in different settings, mostly outside the church where the people live their everyday lives. Over time and in the process, you will begin to see where God uses you the most. Keep on being faithful in that, and God will confirm your calling.

When I started serving in the ministry, I did street witnessing, handing out tracts, sharing Christ one-on-one with people. I served by cleaning floors and bathrooms, cooking, doing dishes, etc. Then I remember when I first ministered from behind a pulpit.... It took 6 years from the time when I first began to serve to the time when I was first entrusted with the task of preaching from behind a pulpit.

Even when I taught in a large Bible college, I kept on serving. I remember the time when I noticed that my Pastor's shoes were unpolished so I went to his home and polished all his shoes until they shone.

MINISTRY is not just about preaching from behind a pulpit or about doing what people call "great things." The word *minister* in the Greek, used 27 times in the New Testament, is the word *Diakonos*, which means "one who executes the commands of another, especially of a master, a servant, attendant." It comes from the old word *Diak* which means "to run errands." So MINISTRY is all about SERVICE.

Don't look for a "higher place" with a title, but look for a "lower place" - a place of servanthood and service. Serve and show yourself faithful. The Lord may have called you to be in the five-fold ministry gifts. Or, He may have called you to serve as a lay-person in the ministry of



helps. Whatever it is, you will find it and you will see how you will find great joy and fulfillment in the place of service that the Lord has prepared for you.

Remember that EVERY position of service in God's Kingdom is a HIGH

Calling, be it "exalted" or "small" in the eyes of man. Everything is significant in the eyes of God. So serve, rejoice, and fulfill your destiny!

Above all, keep fervent in your love for one another, because love covers a multitude of sins. Be hospitable to one another without complaint. As each one has received a special gift, employ it in serving one another as good stewards of the manifold grace of God. Whoever speaks, is to do so as one who is speaking the utterances of God; whoever serves is to do so as one who is serving by the strength which God supplies; so that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom belongs the glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen. 1 Peter 4:8-11

Being Christlike...

"Because of that obedience, God lifted him high and honored him far beyond anyone or anything, ever, so that all created beings in heaven and on earth—even those long ago dead and buried—will bow in worship before this Jesus Christ, and call out in praise that he is the Master of all, to the glorious honor of God the Father". Philippians 2:5-11 (The Message)

Think of yourselves the way Christ Jesus thought of himself.

He had equal status with God but didn't think so much of himself that he had to cling to the advantages of that status no matter what.

Not at all. When the time came, he set aside the privileges of deity and took on the status of a slave, and became human! Having become human, he stayed human.

It was an incredibly humbling process. He didn't claim special privileges. Instead, he lived a selfless, obedient life. And then, died a selfless, obedient death—and the worst kind of death at that—a crucifixion.
