2015 has been a good and blessed year for our ministry. As we look back, we are grateful to our Lord for all the things that He has done. Huge multitudes of souls have come to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ. We have seen the lame walk, the blind see,

the deaf hear and the mute speak. In each and every service, the Gospel message has been confirmed by our Lord through mighty signs, wonders, and miracles – exactly according to the pattern that we see in the Bible!

# 2015: Year in review...

## GOSPEL CRUSADES:

12 Gospel crusades were held this year. 9 in Africa, 2 in North India, and 1 in Eastern Ukraine.

We were blessed to see large multitudes at our altar calls. Entire towns were shaken by the power of God! Due to our effective pre-crusade training and post-crusade follow-up programs for churches, we saw revival break out in several places after the crusades. Local churches grew and multiplied.

Tens of thousands received the baptism with the Holy Ghost and with Fire in these crusades. Great multitudes were healed

from different kinds of diseases and infirmities: the lame, blind, deaf, and deaf-mutes healed by the power of God!

## TEACHING AND PREACHING:

I travelled all over the world sharing the Gospel in the United States, Europe, Africa, and Asia. Large numbers of people came to Jesus, and many were saved!

**CHURCHES:** Our AWAKE Church movement has been growing with many new churches planted. Right now we are over 450 congregations in 5 African countries, as well as, in England.

## ORPHANAGE AND BIBLE

**SCHOOL:** 7 of our orphans on the AWAKE farm have grown up and left. Some are now married. We now have 8 orphans remaining, and they are growing up fast!

**HUMANITARIAN HELP:** The government of Zimbabwe has presented a request for wheelchairs, and so far we have been able to donate 20 to various hospitals.

*For all this, we give all glory and honor to our wonderful Lord Jesus, for He alone is worthy!*

# "COME! LIVE! DIE!"

Six years before I received Jesus, in 1969, I was a cadet at the Air Force College. My dad, an army officer, was commanding the 59th Field Regiment of Artillery in Lahore Cantonment, Pakistan. Whenever I was on leave, I used to take my .22 rifle and go shooting in the outskirts of the regimental lines.

One day, as I was walking through the snake-infested overgrown jungle of trees, vines, and bushes, I stumbled upon a crumbling old wall covered with vines. I climbed over the wall and found myself in an ancient cemetery. I began to read the inscriptions on the gravestones. They were very old, from the 1800's. Some graves were solitary. Others were in pairs. And, some were of entire families buried side by side, husband and wife with children in graves of varying sizes.

As I read the inscriptions, I understood that these were graves of Englishmen and Scotsmen who had come to that part of the world as missionaries and had died in the mission field. After reading the inscriptions, I walked away from there and forgot all about the place.

Over 46 years later, only just recently, the Holy Spirit reminded me of that old, crumbling, abandoned

cemetery in the Punjab. Now, today, I know much more of the history of missions to that region. Missionaries from England and Scotland, full of zeal for Jesus and for His Gospel, left everything and took their families with them to the field.

With all the diseases around those days, the rate of attrition was very high. These missionaries knew that there was very little chance of returning home. So, they would pack their belongings in wooden coffins instead of cases or trunks.

They preached the Gospel, facing terrible odds. Rather than quit, they died on the field preaching to the lost. Their families died with them. I remember the graves of one and two year old children buried beside their parents.

Today their bones lie forgotten in abandoned old cemeteries all over the foreign field, thousands of miles away from home. England and Scotland have forgotten them, but they are known in Heaven where their names shine brightly as the stars in the sky. As they lie there, they are waiting to hear the sound of the trumpet when Christ returns. They were buried in weakness, but they shall rise in Glory!

As a new believer, the stories of such men and women moved me, inspired me. We, who have given our lives to the preaching of the Gospel to the lost today, carry the heritage left behind by those heroes of old. We are reaping with joy the harvest from the precious seed that they sowed with tears.

Our lives are far easier and more comfortable than theirs, but we still have to pay a price, and that is laying down our own ambitions and lives to take up the cross and follow Jesus. We are walking on paths of Glory, treading on the Bloodstained footprints of our Master, and of His saints who gave everything for the sake of the Gospel.

Today, my thoughts go back to those whose bodies lie in that forgotten cemetery outside the regimental lines of the 59th Field Regiment of Artillery, and I can hear our Lord Jesus saying,

*"Follow me, and I will make you Fishers of men."  
Matthew 4:19*

*"If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow me. For whosoever will save his life shall lose it: but whosoever will lose his life for my sake, the same shall save it." Luke 9:23-24*

In the words of my old mentor, George Verwer, who God used to light the fire of missions in my heart,  
**"COME! LIVE! DIE!"**

**W**e are reaching people who are so utterly lost and without hope. Only Jesus Christ can set them free through His Gospel. We have given our lives, and are asking you to give of your finances and resources to help us to get the job done!

Time is short, and the harvest fields are vast. The challenge is great, but standing together we can make a

difference! We have preached in war zones, in Muslim lands, in perilous places, and we are seeing the fruit – multitudes are coming to Jesus Christ to receive Eternal Life. These are tough times, but if we never give up and continue to preach the Gospel no matter what the cost, we shall always win!
