# The Great Commission

*Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: Teaching them to observe all things... Matt. 28:19 & 20*

*...Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. Mark 16:15*

1. "GO into ALL THE WORLD and PREACH THE GOSPEL to EVERY Creature"
2. "MAKE DISCIPLES of all nations"
3. "TEACHING THEM all things"

So the task we have at hand is reaching the lost, making disciples, and teaching believers the full counsel of the Word of God.

The Great Commission is not just about reaching the lost, but it is also about making disciples of Jesus. The Great Commission is not just about evangelists, but it involves all of the 5 ministry gifts (Ephesians 4:11) and the Church at large. It involves every single person who calls Jesus Christ his Lord.

We should therefore not only win the lost, but also make every Believer a disciple, who reaches the people in his personal sphere of influence with the Gospel.

These days there is a lot of priority on "life coaching" and "leadership training". These things may have their place, but they are not the primary issues at hand. The primary issues are putting in place certain

Biblical priorities, namely; preaching the gospel, making disciples, getting Believers filled with the Holy Ghost and power, and doing the works of Jesus. Then we can work on training leaders.

We should, however, remember that the very best leaders are men and women whose primary focus is to be more like Jesus. Jesus was the greatest leader ever, and those who strive to be like Him become good leaders.

In Exodus 33:11 we read, *“The Lord would speak to Moses face to face, as one speaks to a friend. Then Moses would return to the camp, but his young aide Joshua son of Nun did not leave the tent.”* (NIV)

Moses would seek the face of God in the tabernacle, and the Lord would speak to Him. His servant Joshua would be with him in the tabernacle, watching everything. He watched how Moses would seek the Lord, and how the Lord would speak to Moses. Moses would then go out of the tabernacle to address the people, but Joshua would stay in the tabernacle.

When I have finished my course here on earth and I go home to be with Jesus, I want people just to say this one thing about me, “Christopher Alam loved Jesus, and he loved People.”
