

# THIS IS THE TIME!

In our society, money is everything for so many people. Just imagine, a man coming to the conclusion that his life was no longer worth living just because he had lost his money.

The Apostle Paul said, *"Charge them that are rich in this world, that they be not highminded, nor trust in uncertain riches, but in the living God..."*

I Timothy 6:17

Note that Paul is telling us that the riches of this world are fleeting and uncertain. Isaac sowed in the time of famine and God responded with abundant blessings. God blessed him so much so that the enemy envied him. After that we see Isaac going into a well-

digging spree in the desert during that time of drought and famine, and each well that he dug yielded forth water. God was blessing him!

Finally, in verse 24 God said to Isaac, *"...fear not, for I am with thee, and will bless thee, and multiply thy seed..."*

**So, this is time to sow seed.** But it is also time for another very important thing; namely, **it is time for harvest!**

Our Lord Jesus said, *"Say not ye, There are yet four months, and then cometh harvest? behold, I say unto you, Lift up your eyes, and look on the fields; for they are white already to harvest. And he that reapeth receiveth wages, and gathereth fruit unto life eternal: that both he that soweth and he that reapeth may rejoice together."* John 4:35-36

With the shaking of the economic situation in the world today, people who have put their security in the uncertain riches of this world are also being shaken. Because of this, people are open to hearing about Jesus and the Eternal security that He gives, more than ever before. We who are Christians must therefore share Christ with the people around us. We must preach the Gospel. This is the time!
